


Annual Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Enrollment












Student Credit Hour Production by Course Level for Academic Year 2016-2017



Student Credit Hour Production by Department, Academic Year 2016-2017



















School of Graduate and Professional Studies Total Degrees Conferred by Academic Year





General Studies Total Fall Enrollment (Headcount)







Fall 2016 First-Time Freshmen Enrolled in Remediation


