



#### Historic Full-Time & Part-Time Enrollment













### Degrees Awarded - AY 2007-2008





### **Sophomore Fall Enrollment by Year**




### Junior Fall Enrollment by Year


### Enrollment by Age Percentage of Students Under 25






#### White Undergraduate Fall Enrollment by Year


### Hispanic/Latino Undergraduate Fall Enrollment by Year






### American Indian/ Alaska Native Undergraduate Fall Enrollment by Year




### Nonresident Alien Undergraduate Fall Enrollment by Year










#### Black or African American Graduate Fall Enrollment by Year






### Hispanic/ Latino Graduate Fall Enrollment by Year






### American Indian/ Alaska NativeGraduate Fall Enrollment by Year


### Nonresident Alien Graduate Fall Enrollment by Year




### **Students from Grady County**



# Graduate Programs Degrees Awarded by Ethnicity AY 2007-2008






## Adult & Continuing Education Total Fall Undergraduate Enrollment










