






Annual Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Enrollment



















Fall 2010 Percentage of Enrollment by School



















Adult and Continuing Education Total Undergraduate Degrees Conferred by Academic Year









General Studies Total Fall Undergraduate Enrollment (Headcount)




