


Annual Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Enrollment











Student Credit Hour Production by School Academic Year 2012-2013




























Adult and Continuing Education Total Undergraduate Degrees Conferred by Academic Year







General Studies Total Fall Enrollment (Headcount)








