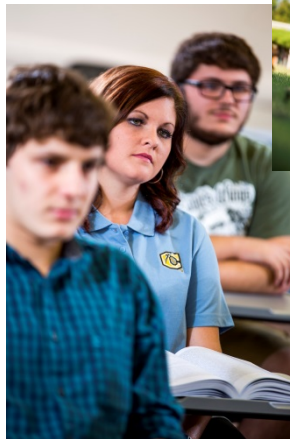

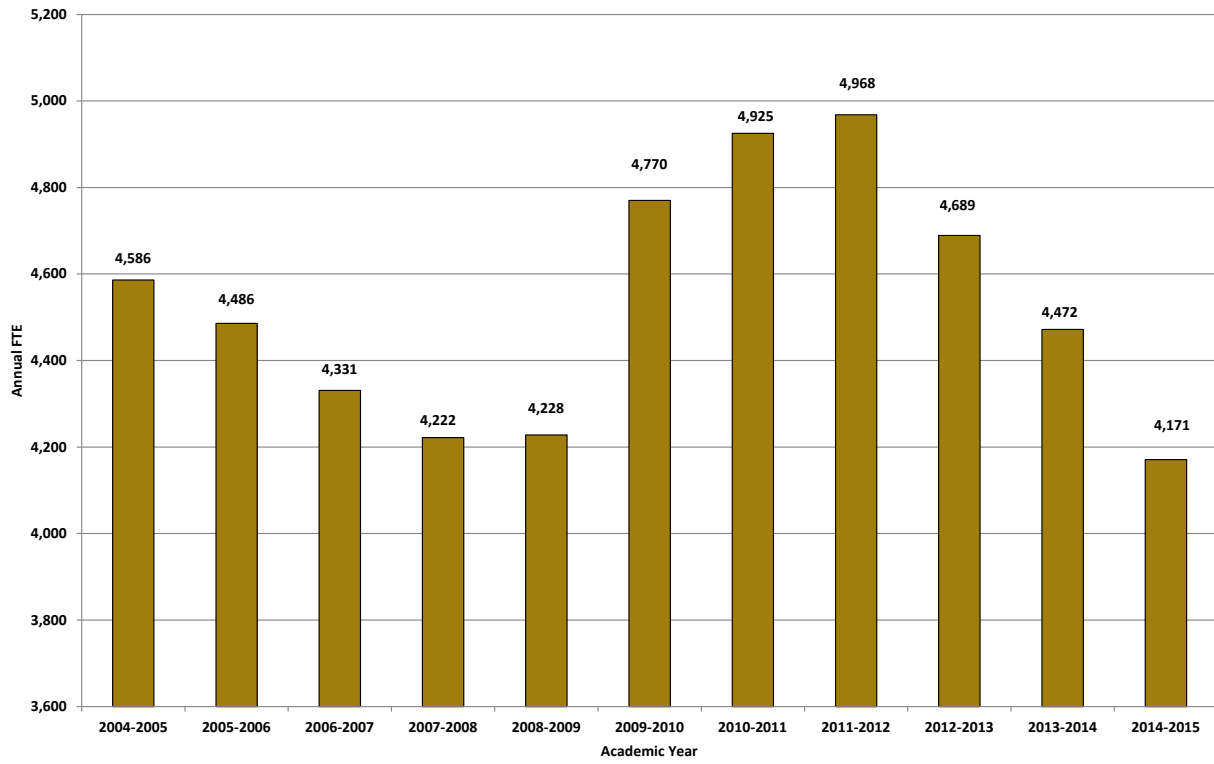

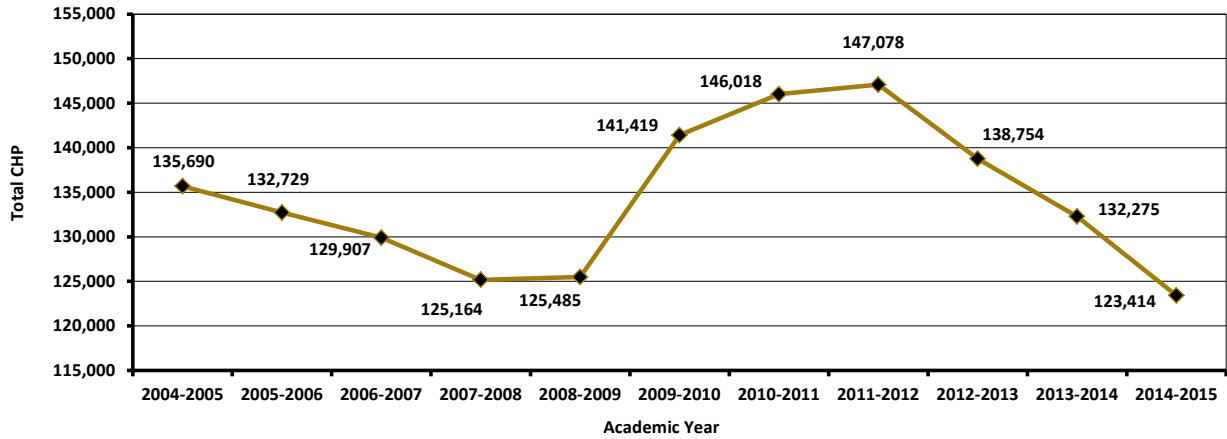
Annual Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Enrollment





Student Credit Hour Production by Academic Year (Summer, Fall, Spring)

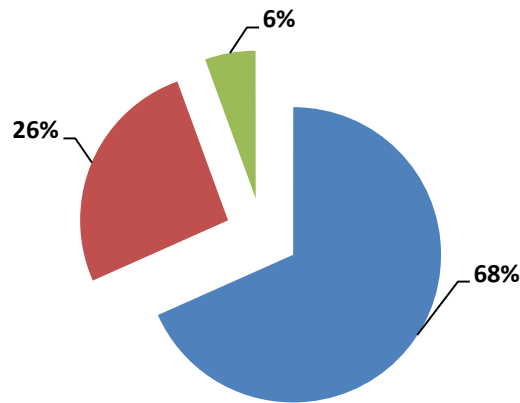

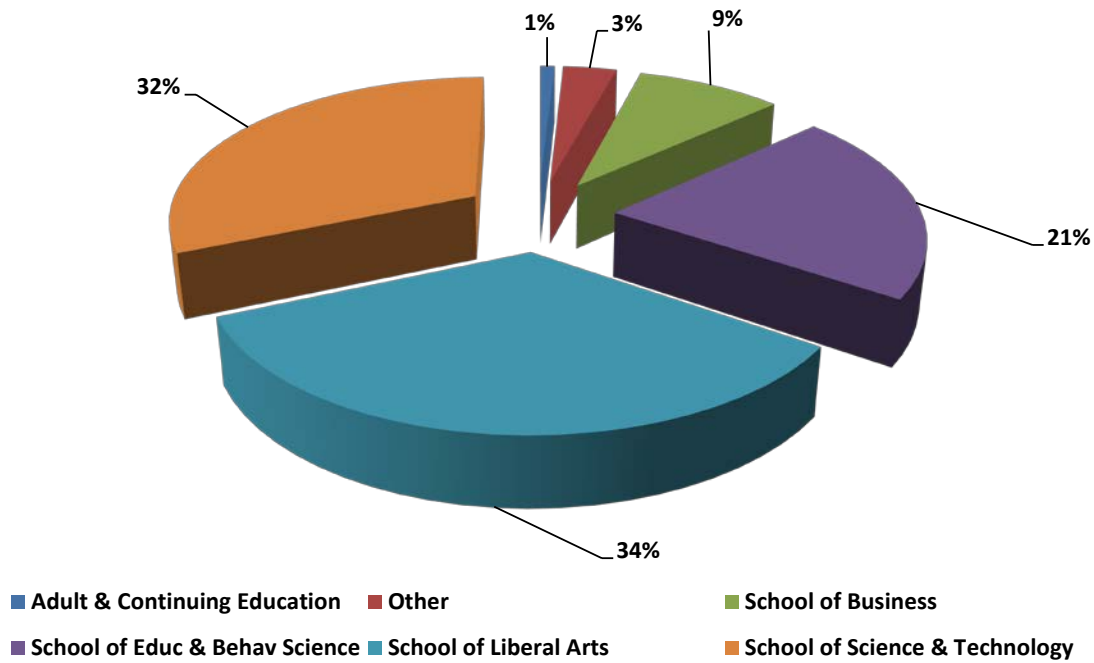

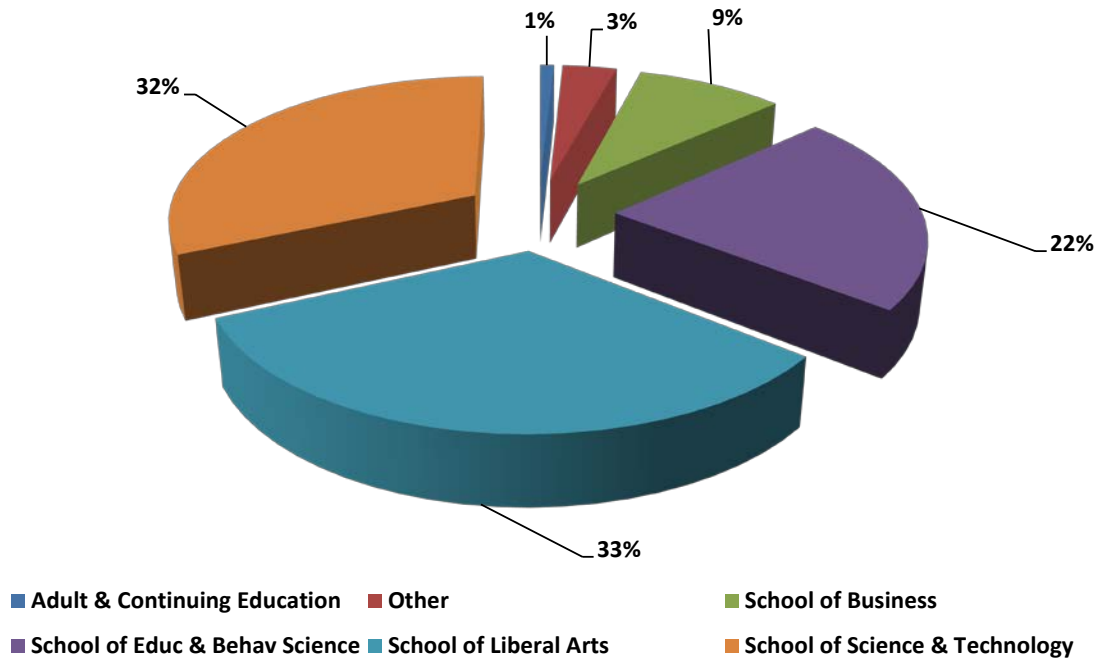

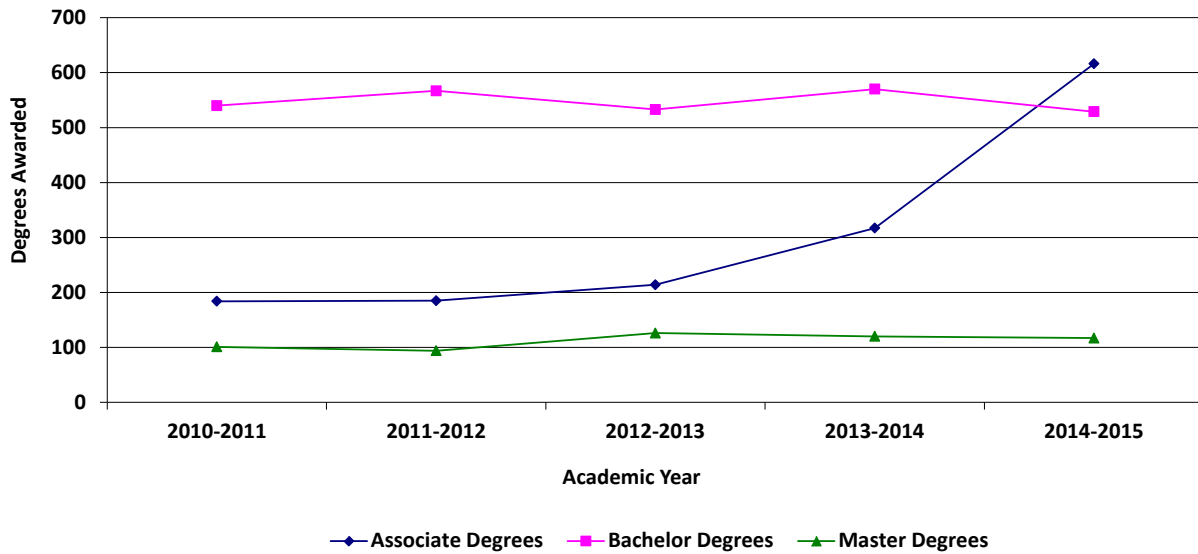

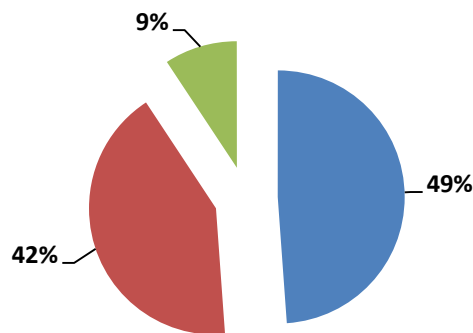

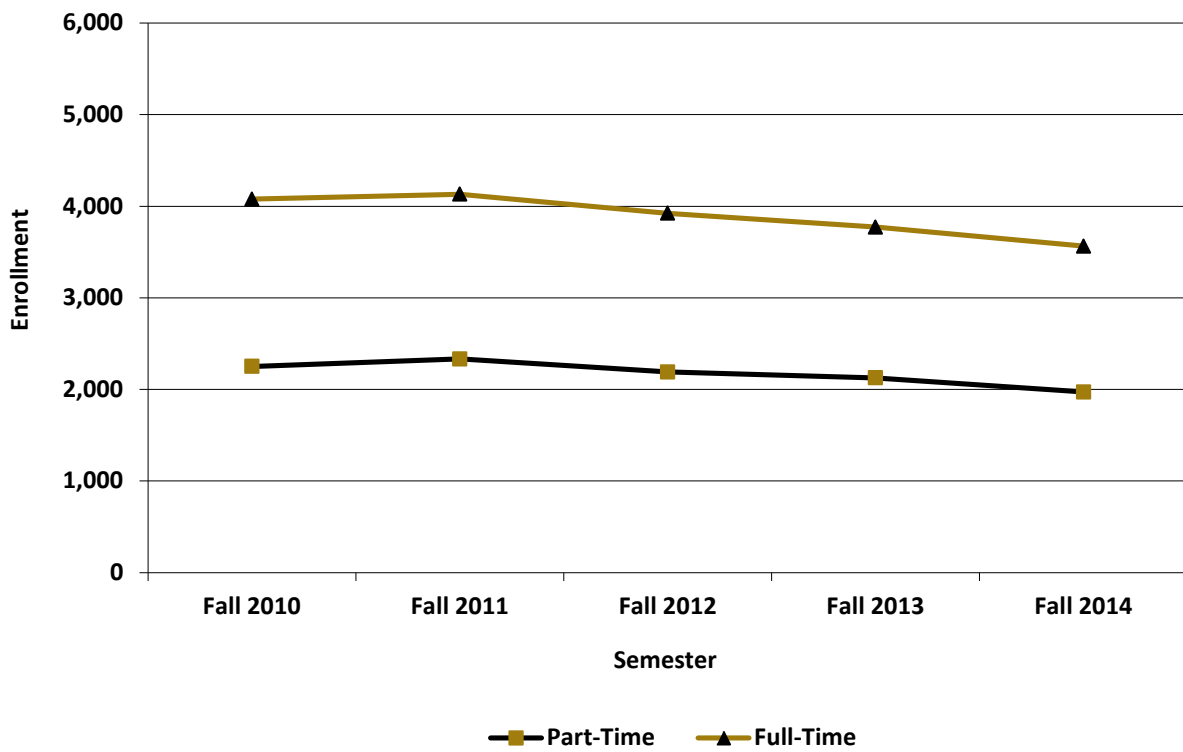

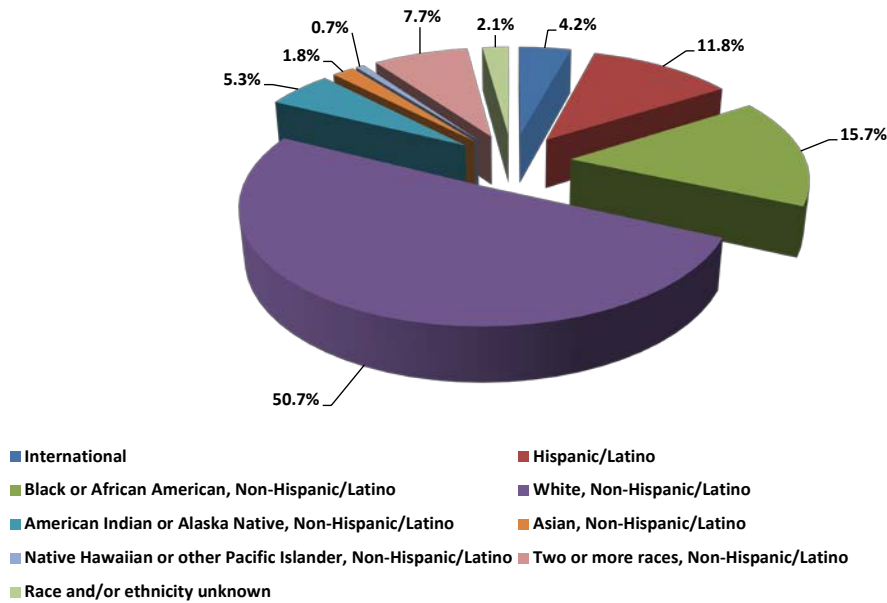

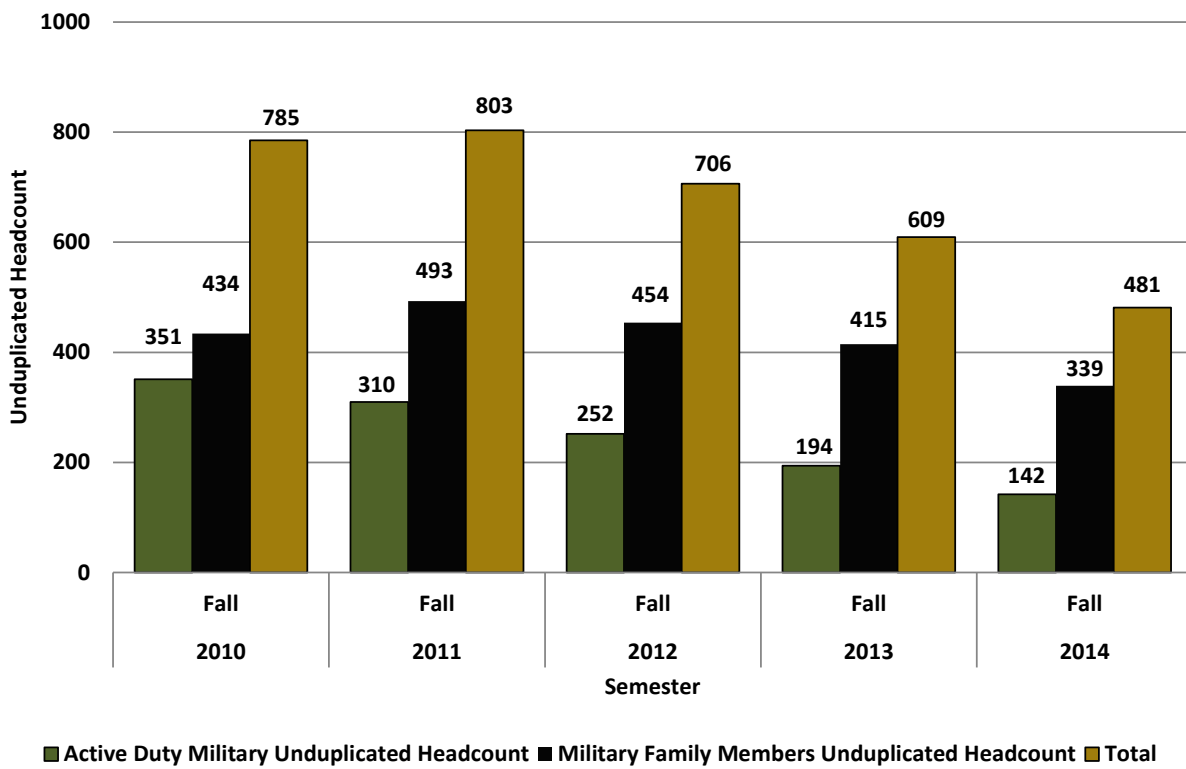

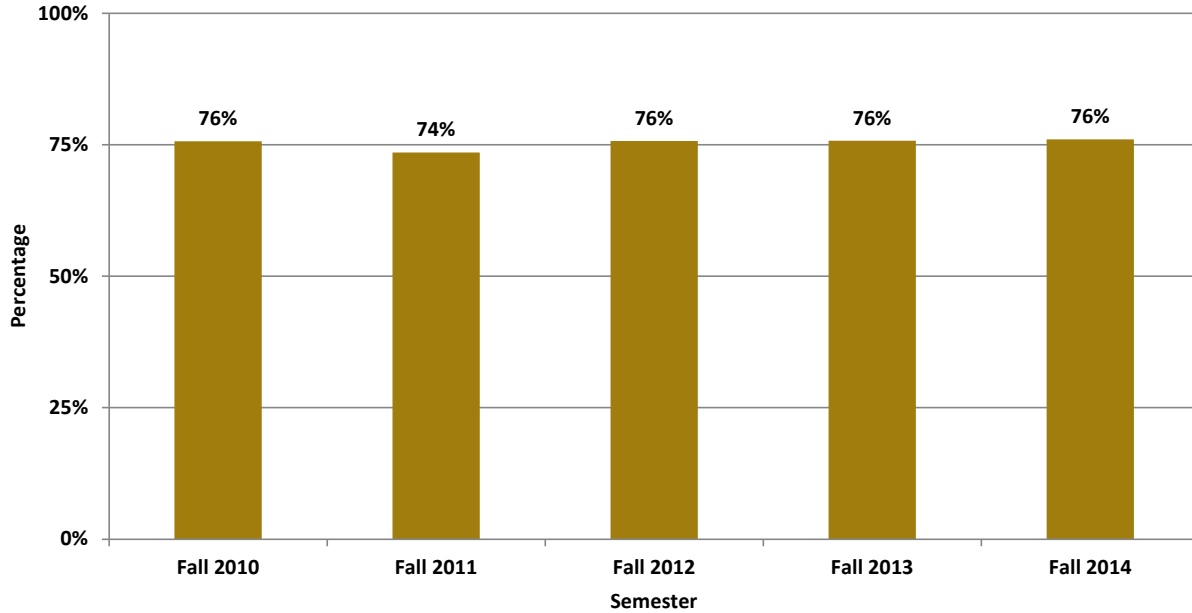

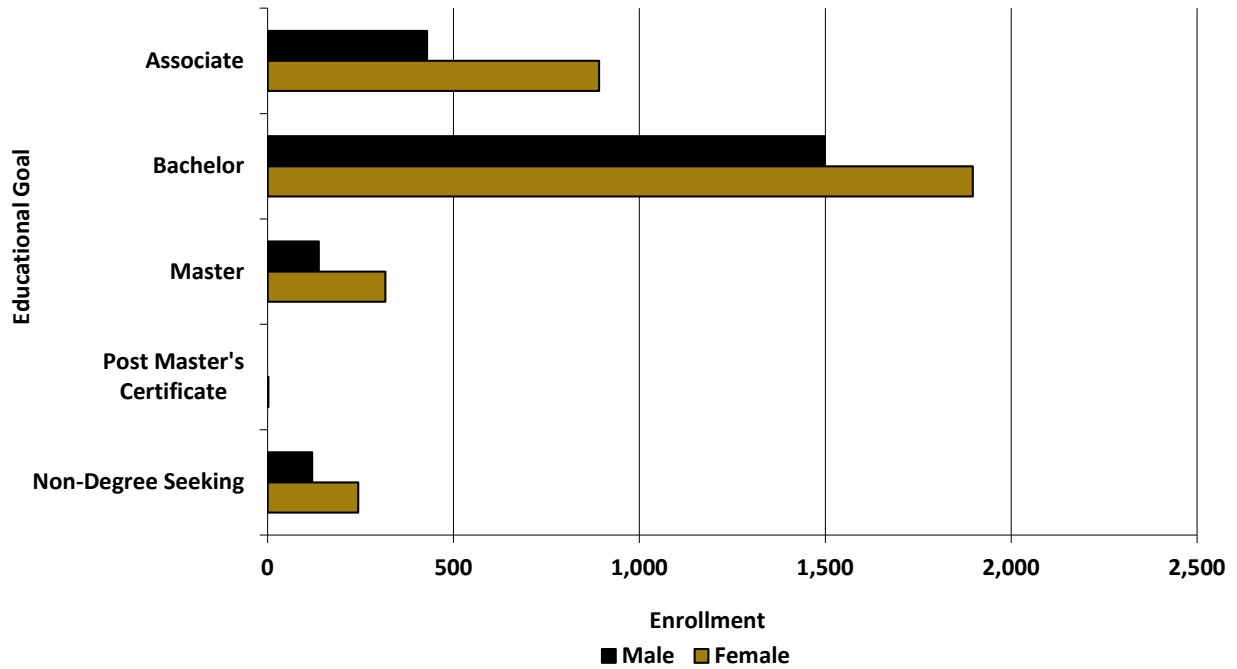

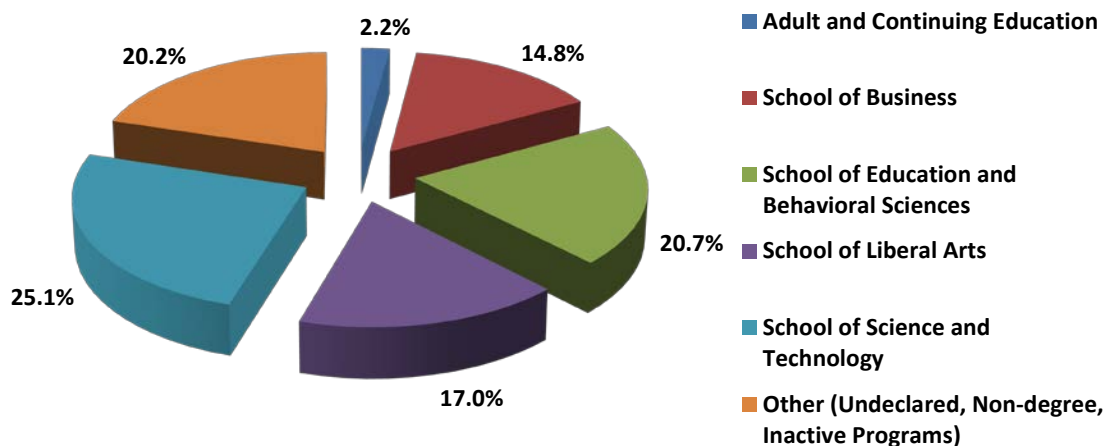

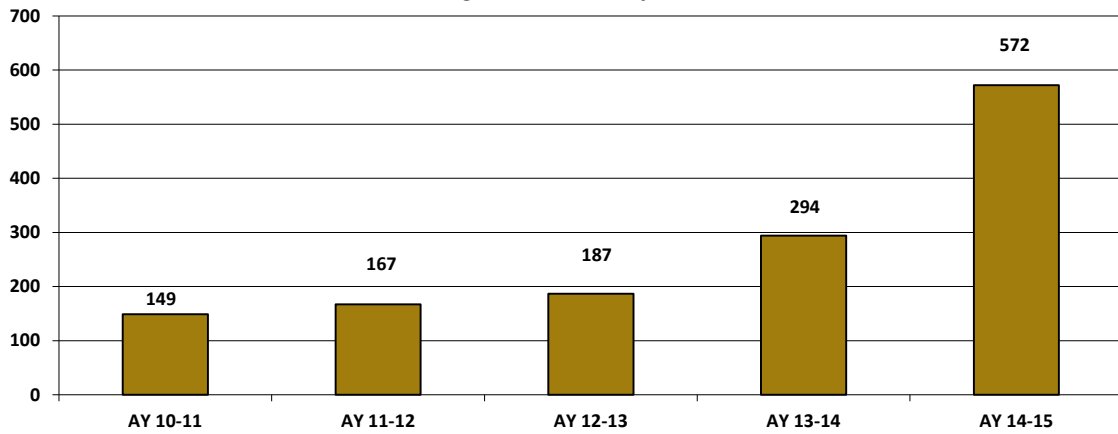

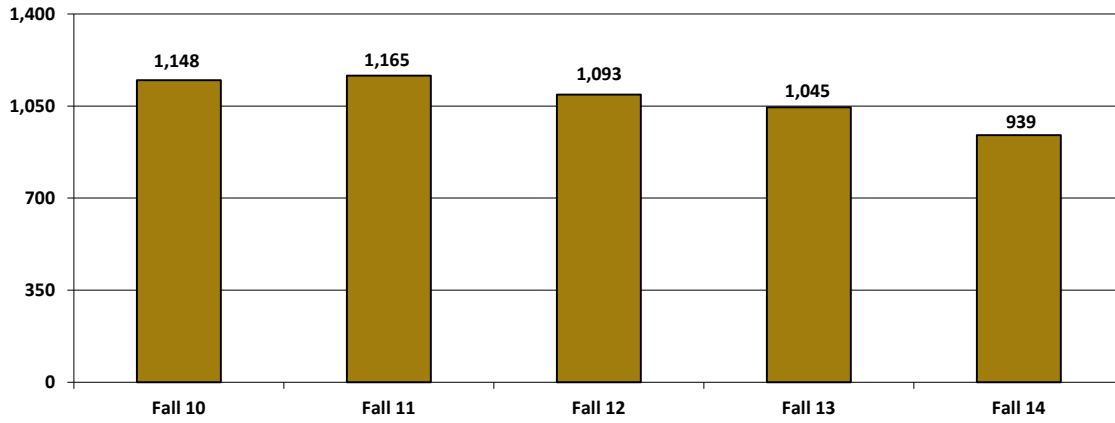

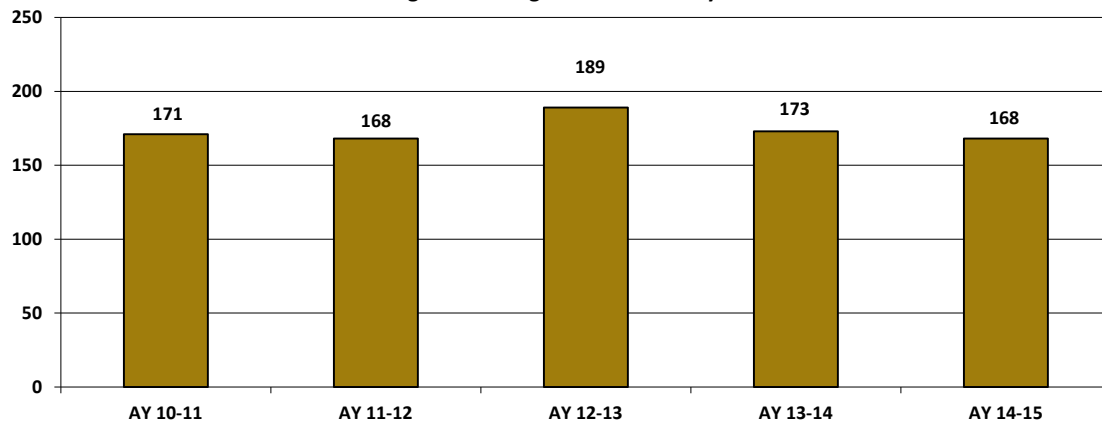

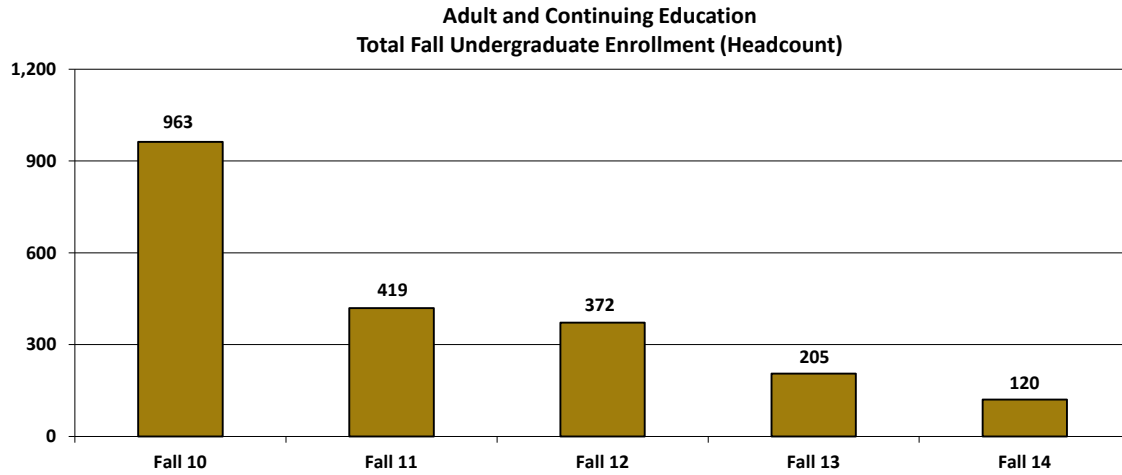

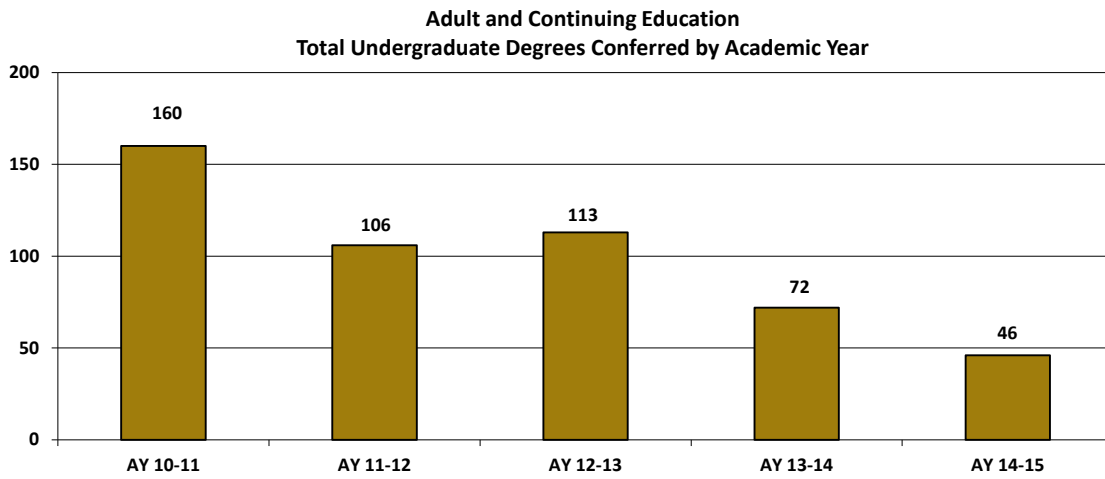

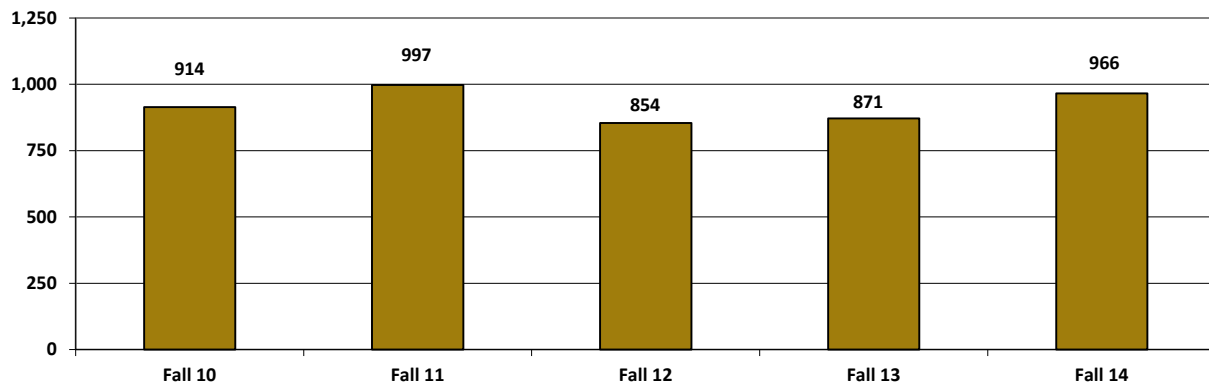

General Studies Total Fall Enrollment (Headcount)



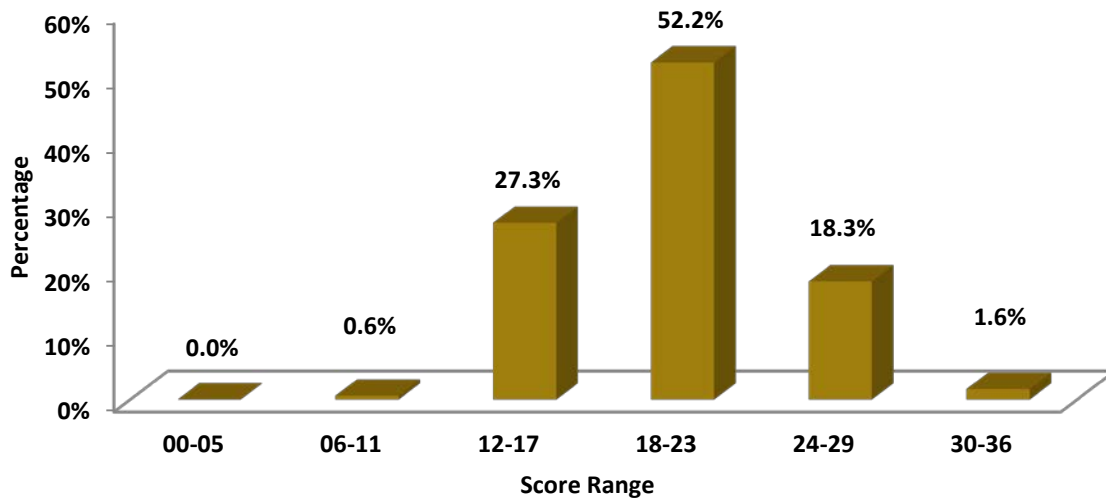

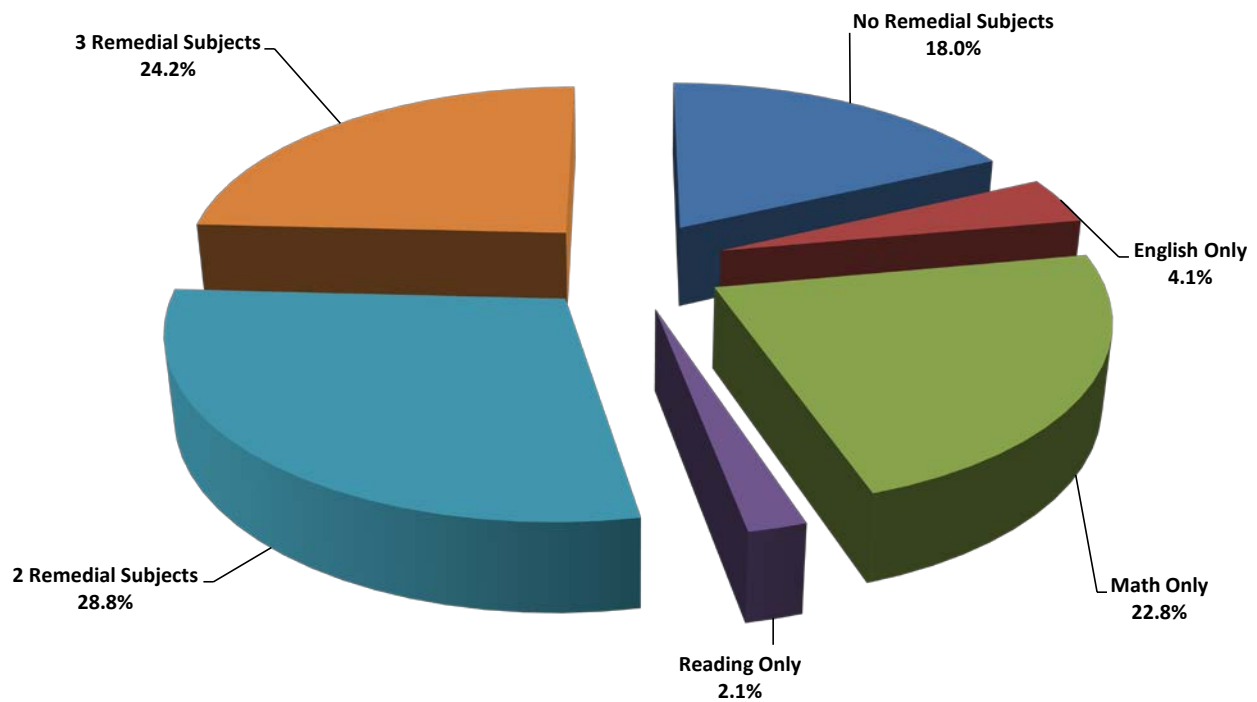

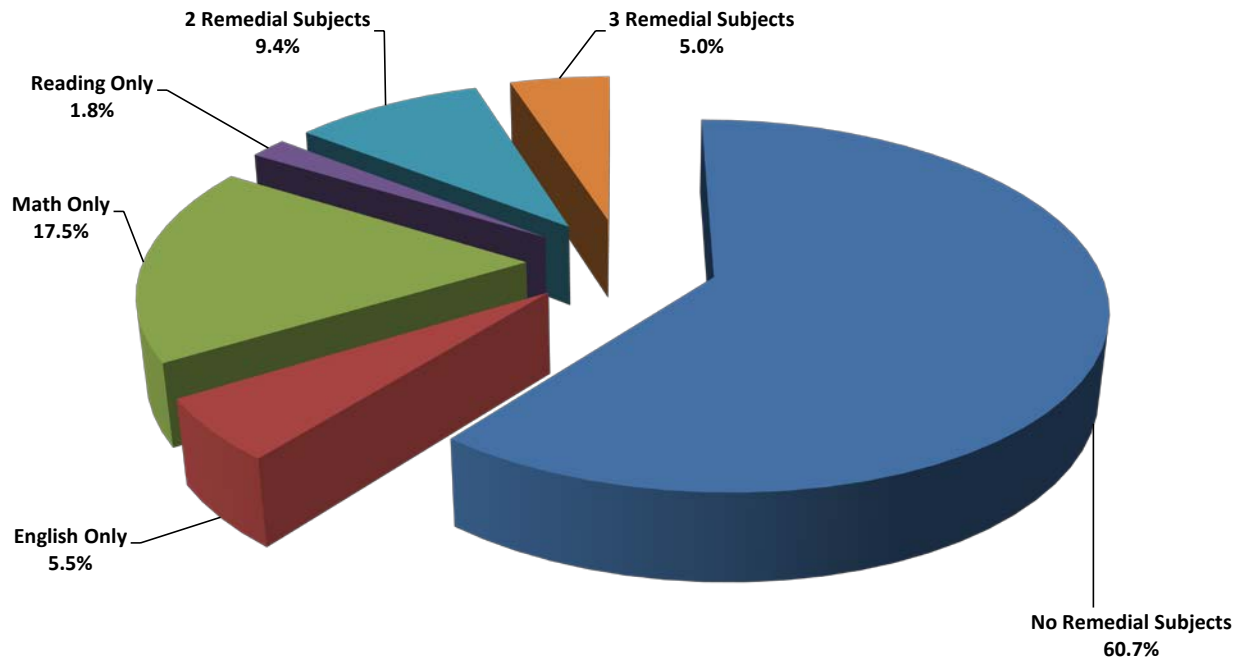
