


## Annual Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Enrollment











#### Student Credit Hour Production by School, Academic Year 2015-2016





















# Adult and Continuing Education Total Undergraduate Degrees Conferred by Academic Year





# General Studies Total Fall Enrollment (Headcount)









The Teacher Education programs are accredited by the State by the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation (OCTP) and by the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE).

#### School of Liberal Arts

The Bachelor of Arts in Music, Bachelor of Music Education, and Bachelor of Music degrees offered by the Department of Music are accredited by the National Association of Schools of Music (NASM).

#### School of Science and Technology

The Bachelor of Science, Medical Laboratory Science concentration, is affiliated with Comanche County Memorial Hospital's Medical Technology/Clinical Laboratory Science Program that is accredited by the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences (NAACLS).

The Bachelor of Science in Chemistry (Professional Option) offered by the Department of Chemistry, Physics, and Engineering is certified by the American Chemical Society (ACS).
